

HIGHLIGHTS

- 3747 individuals were trained across 87 trainings.
- The bulk of PD trainings focused on Observation & Assessment, Social and Emotional Development, and Management & Administration.
- There are currently 449 programs participating in Stars; 327 are center-based programs and 122 are home-based programs.
- TAs engaged in 58 communities of practice with center-based and family child care providers.




Figure 2. Models for Trainings


Figure 1. Total Live Workshops Table 1. Active Sponsori

As is shown in Figure 3, 70% of child care centers in Delaware are participating in Delaware Stars. Additionally, 19% of FCC and 43% of LFCC participate in Stars, as of March 31, 2021. Participation rates for Title 1, Part B/619, Head Start, and ECAP programs are also presented, as of January 2021. These latter participation rates will be updated again in January 2022.





Figure 5. Star Level Breakdown for L/FCC



As was presented in the previous quarterly data report, there are large differences in the star level breakdown for center-based and L/FCC programs. Just about half of all center-based programs are SL5, compared to just 19% of L/FCC programs. Additionally, just 13% of center-based programs are SL1 and SL2, while 38% of L/FCC programs are SL1 and SL2.

During the current quarter, 9 programs closed, 1 program enrolled, 42 programs were placed on OCCL enforcement action, and 36 programs were removed from OCCL enforcement action. The total numbers of center-based and L/FCC programs at each star level are also reported. While there is no star level movement at this time, the star level breakdown shifts each quarter due to closures, with-drawals, new enrollments, and OCCL enforcement action.
