

"Developing Relationships, Developing Brains: Infants and Toddlers"

The Learning Center - Milford, Del. Creating a Legacy of Quality

The Learning Center, better known as TLC, has a long history of providing quality early childhood education to the Milford community. This past December, TLC celebrated its 41st anniversary. The center was one of the first Delaware Stars programs. And for most of its existence, 36 years to be important jobs of an infant/toddler early childhood professional. The first three years of life are a period of rapid and significant brain growth. Strong caregiver-infant relationships and responsive interactions shape the brain, support social development, and promote lifelong psychological and emotional functioning.

Because caring for and teaching this age group requires specific skills, we developed this professional learning experience to meet early childhood professionals' needs and the needs of the children they care for.

In this professional learning experience, we take different perspectives to look at the connection between relationships and how the brain grows. Participants will walk away knowing more about brain development, their roles as brain builders, and be able to plan more effective and strong daily interactions with the infants and toddlers in their care.

"Developing Relationships, Developing Brains: Infants and Toddlers," is for infant/toddler teachers, family child care professionals, home visitors, and anyone looking to strengthen their knowledge of brain exact, Cheryl Clendaniel has been a part of this mainstay in early childhood education.

"More than one-third of the children enrolled had a parent who attended TLC," said Cheryl, program administrator. "We also have staff members that attended here as children."

TLC serves about 125 children from ages infant to preschool and also runs a school-age program. The staff includes 22 teachers in addition to four administrative positions.

In a field where there is a high turnover rate, the average tenure for staff at TLC is ten years.

"We look for ways to invest in our teachers beyond salary," said Cheryl. "We allow for planning time, sessions with our curriculum coordinator, and provide activities to build community. We have high expectations for our teachers, but we make sure they know they are appreciated."

"High expectations," applies to TLC's approach to delivering quality care and education. While they were one of the first programs to join Stars in 2008, they were in no hurry to rush through the Star Levels.

Cheryl was intentional about being "slow and methodical" in understanding the standards. "I wanted to live the standards and embed them into our practice," said Cheryl. "It's about the journey; it's not about a checklist. Delaware Stars is the framework that pushes us to continue our quest for quality." This approach has paid off – in 2017, the program received its Star Level 5 designation.

DELAWARE STARS QRIS REVISION UPDATES

Thank you for your interest in the Delaware Stars Revision Process. As a key stakeholder in this work, we believe it is important to provide you with an update on where the revision process currently stands.

During the past several months, the State Leadership Team has been meeting regularly to review and reflect on the revision process for the Delaware Stars and has met with the statewide Delaware Stars Advisory Committee to discuss the work to date and how best to proceed. As a result of these conversations, the state has come to a better understanding of the inherent challenges in this type of work and the unique needs of Delaware stakeholders that will better inform the development of a revised system.

Recent activities for the revision process include:

 Clarifying the roles, responsibilities, and expectations for individuals and organizations involved in the revision process; Sussex County, Kent County and New Castle County
