

Considering participating in the ECAP or Redding program?

As an early childhood educator, you know the value of being well-informed and prepared. The Delaware Department of Education invites you to attend the **Request for Proposal (RFP) pre-bid meeting** and get all the information you need to make informed decisions about submitting for Redding and ECAP funds.

WHAT IS ECAP?

The Early Childhood Assistance Program (ECAP) is a state funding stream through the Department of Education (DOE) to provide preschool programming for eligible three- and four-year-old children. ECAP provides educational and comprehensive experiences for all participating children and their families.

WHAT IS REDDING?

For programs serving children who live in the City of Wilmington, Redding Full-Day Preschool is a separate funding stream with similar programming requirements. Redding programs follow ECAP Policies and Procedures but with a few key differences.
