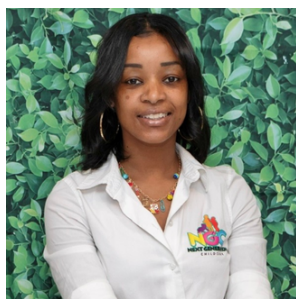

Developmental Screening Policy Update

At the May 20, 2025, Delaware Early Childhood Council (DECC) meeting, the Delaware Department of Education, Early Childhood Support team shared that they would be extending the "Hold Harmless" timeline and would not cite for non-compliance for developmental screening requirements through June 30, 2026. Beginning July 1, 2026, programs that are applying for childcare license renewals will need to comply with the developmental screening requirements, which will be set forth in the coming months.

Quality Improvement Planning

The Delaware Department of Education (DDOE) and Office of Early Learning (OEL) will soon share important information about the FY26 Quality Improvement Awards process. We strongly recommend connecting with a Quality Improvement Specialist early; support requests for quality improvement planning are scheduled in the order they are received. Starting now will help you start the new school year with a solid quality improvement plan and ensure your program is ready to move forward once updated award information is available.
